
Co-President's Report - Elaine Lee-Wong/Simone Dornbach

New Business/ Open Forum

- Kindergarten applications is open 12/10 through 1/19
- Middle School D28 sent out a flyer for middle school virtual open house it is posted on our Facebook page & AEA administration sent it to 5th grade families.
- Nothing on Pre-K admissions yet usually comes after kindergarten
- AEA applied for a waiver for exception to the proposed DOE blended model prior to the beginning of the school year to allow for our current blended model - so we might not see a lot of changes. Our administration is still looking at more options to increase in-person learning days - If you are in 2nd or 4th grade blended learning, you should have gotten a survey - please respond if you have not done so already.
