## Treasurer's Report – Vincent Roulot

- January 2022
  - Opening balance: \$87,744.37
  - Income: \$12,330.59 (Annual Fund & Matching)
  - Expenses: \$252.56 Ice Pack for school nurse
  - Ending balance: \$99,822.40
- Annual Fund Total raised to date \$22,049.03 some more still to add from corporate matching donations.

## President's Report – Stacey

- Aigner Chocolates Golden Ticket Fundraiser \$283 raised
- Funding a Broadway performance Mrs Bonthuys is asking if the PTA can fund the purchase of rights to a Broadway show (Annie for 2022) for 4<sup>th</sup> grade students. This will give the school permission to use the full scripts, music, digital choreography, license to tape and distribute, scenery projections, T-Shirts for all students involved to put on a professional show. Without these rights it is very limiting with regard to what we are allowed to stage. Total cost \$1,786.50 \*\*We will add this line item to the recurring budget for the PTA.

The PTA has repeatedly asked the staff for anything we can fund, and has also reminded them more recently we are ready and willing to help. When we asked them more recently their reasons for opting to use Donors Choose, response was variety of reasons from not realizing they could come to PTA (some are new and this was not a resource they had in prior schools, for existing staff this is also new as in previous years we did not have a budget surplus and funds were mostly allocated at the start of the year to big ticket items like an art teacher which was not

funded by the DOE before the 2021-22 school year. We have restated our availability to teachers and will be sending notes to the teachers to remind them we are here to help fund their projects! There are currently 3 live projects live on Donors Choose – asking the PTA if we would like to complete the funding for each them,

## School Leadership Team (SLT) Report – Geraldine Chadenat

- Meeting held 1/4 (regular time 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday of month 7:30am, <u>303SLT@gmail.com</u> to ask questions of parent members)
- Feb Meeting
  - SEL DESSA social emotional learning screening, Ms. Barrett reviewed the results, the goal is to move all students toward "strength" category. Review piloted with the 5<sup>th</sup> grade, focus on Personal Responsibility, will be rolled out to the wider student community in September. School is still awaiting guidance from the DOE on what should be communicated further on the topic. For any questions Ms Barrett can be reached at <u>cbarrettaea@gmail.com</u>
  - K Grade Reading Levels Mrs. Leto had expressed concerns on the impact on lower than targeted reading levels for the Kindergarten students in the first semester, this is largely due to the impact of Covid and remote learning on the lower grades. In September 30% of K students were testing below grade level. The teachers have put extra focus and dedicated resources to reading with the students, as of February only 12% are below and there will be continued focus in this area to get all students where they need to be.
